Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA™) the national accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state of the art standards in four areas: policy and procedures, operations and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Wednesday, May 30th, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. The session will be conducted at the Council Chambers at Richard J. Martel Municipal Complex, 475 Corporate Drive, Mahwah, New Jersey 07430.

The general public and agency employees are also invited to offer comments by calling 201-831-2077 and 201-831-2080 on Wednesday, May 30th, 2018 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by members of the assessment team.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session, are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA standards.
