Academic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Completion of required/elective courses in the career pathway totaling 48 credits ➤ >80% (B) in all pathway focused elective courses 	
Co-curricular	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Active participation in Art Club, Woodworking, or another preapproved engineering or visual arts co-curricular activity 	
Community based	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Successful completion of approved Internship or ➤ approved job shadowing externship minimum five to eight (5-8) hours) or ➤ approved senior capstone project of thirty (30) hours of pre-approved community service related to your selected career pathway or ➤ approved Option Two experience related to your selected career pathway
